Purpose of this note

Donors often ask a simple question: did my rupee become a meal, a medicine, a book, or a wage? This utilisation note answers that question for FY 2025–26. It is a management statement. The signed auditor’s utilisation certificate, when issued, will be posted on the Transparency page.

Two-person approval for every field disbursement above ■5,000. Photo and register evidence for ration distributions. Quarterly Board review of cause-wise balances. No cash handled by a single volunteer. Online payments verified server-side before a donation is marked successful.

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
